John Lewis, son of Arthyr and Margret Lewis, was born in Gamlan Uchaf [Upper Canal] in the Aberdare Parish, Glamorganshire, on the 5th day of September in the year 1807, and married Mary Morris in the Aberdare Church, Glamorganshire, in May in the year 1830, and fathered 8 children, and was baptized by one of the Latter-day Saints by the name of Alfred Clark.

Held family prayer. 3rd, I wrote [kept minutes] at the Council. Held family prayer. 4th, at the Saints' Meeting writing. 5th, held family prayer. 6th, held family prayer. 7th, Sunday, at home writing; unable to

- Elder Rees Lewelyn anointed, and I received the blessing completely when there were three witnesses—Dd Lewelyn and Mary Lewis, my wife, and Elder Rees Lewelyn. After that I went to the Council; wrote until it was over, and the ague came back. I asked the President to administer to me, and so President Richd B. Lewis and James Phillips laid their hands on me. I received complete relief in a short time. Held family prayer. 29th, at the Saints' meeting writing. Held family prayer. 30th, was at home writing.
