 we again went to gether at 6 o'clock. Bro Morse opened by Prayer, Bro Daly was
 called to address the Congregation. The Mob was there and was very annoying and
 noisy, the Police had to be called in. Bro Gorgan Evans spoke in Welsh for a
 time. And then Bro Teasdel spoke, with power and with effect, though interrupted by
 the Mob. The Saints felt sorry that they could not worship the Lord in Peace. We held
 Our Conference against the will of the great Mob, we were protected by the Hand
 of the Lord. and felt very thankful, even that we were numbered among the despised
 of the world, (the Saints of God). After meeting we had the pleasure of listening to
 Bro Teasdel. He gave us some valuable instructions, and spoke upon difant
 principles, we were up late with him, Month 4. We had to part with Broos Mc Ald
 and Teasdel, they went on the Morning Train, in the After noon we met again in
 Council to finish the Business, we all received our appointments, and the remainder
 of the evening we spent very happy, singing Songs, recitations, and Music, dancing,
 &c till late hour. Tuesth 5. We was to gether in the Morning, some few had to
 leave, I went up to Giffarthas works in the afternoon, saw Bro Lewis of Logan
 Friend, Mr Gool. He bought the Book Mormon was every kind, I took stroll
 through the works, and came home, to the Conference House, Wedth 6. I went up
 to the Bank in the Morning got the Cheack cashed, Bought Hat, and also two
 Pairs of Socks for the little Boys, and also reading Glass for Father. In the
 Afternoon I went up to Dowlis saw Father old friend David Evans, and also
 others, returned in the Evening. Thursth 7. I made ready to start off, waited to some
 others, started off 2 o'clock, we came as far as Neath, stayed there all Night
 in Bro Williams House, Bro Noah Williams and Bro Lay, and myself, had talk
 with Miss Jones, and returned for the Night. Frid 8. Raining and Snowing bad
 but Bro Lay and myself started off for Swansea, I went to Mr Tylor the Artist
 bargained for my Wife and the Babys Photos to be Painted, then I went down
 to the Victoria Station took the Train for Pontar Dulais, Arrived in the Evening,

found Jenkin and Family in pretty fair health, Sarah had the Head each and
 Jenkin had coald, He made a Frame for the Picture of Lottie and Babys, He fixt
 it up nice, had pleasant-chat with him, stayed all Night, Sat 7th, I started
 of on the 8³⁰, Train, took with me my Uncle and Ante Oil Paintings, stopped
 at Llanelle for a while, called at Scale Cottage, Mrs came with me to the Sta,
 then I proceeded to Carmarthen, Had to stop there for 4 Hours, for the next
 Train, at 3 o'clock I started for Llanbyther, After being walking round
 the City, till I was tired, Met Uncle Thos at the Sta, came Home to gether,
 They liked the Oil Paintings very much, they were proud of them, I Found Letter
 from my Wife waiting me, were very much pleased to learn that they were all enjoying
 good health, Sun 10th, I stayed home all day, done considerable writing especially
 the Journal, in the Evening I in company with Tom Bowen went up to
 Park & Bedw. Mon 11th, I stayed to home, wrote a Letter to my Wife, Tues 12th, I stayed
 to home wrote a Letter to John my Bro, Bought 8 Yards of Flanel from
 Uncle Thos, to make Garments, sent it of to Pembroke Shire, to Bro Morris
 to make, the Flanel cost 12 Shilling, send it of cost 10^{sh}, Wen 13th, I stayed to
 home, and wrote a Letter to J L Edwards, was round some of the Neighbors,
 Thur 14th, I made ready to go to Llanbyther, called at Dolven gave them some Tracts
 and told them of the Book of Mormon, They wanted I should stay to Dinner, I stopped
 and chatted very freely, after Dinner I started off, gave some Tracts on the Road,
 I went to the Blacksmith at Landyar, talkt long time, but He could not see
 the necessity of the restoration, I spoke very plainly to him, then returned to Llanbyther
 called at Davis Store, talked them of my Mission, they had bought the BK of Mor, and was
 well pleased with it, I then called at another Store, had gave them some Tracts
 before, asked them if they had read them, (Yes) I gave some more, and got them to
 buy the BK of Mor, I then visited the Sta Master, Perswaded him to buy
 the Book, I returned Home well pleased, Frid, 15th, I made ready to go Lampeter, wrote
 a Letter to Bro Brough, at Morthyr, found the Fells at Lampeter in good feelings but the
 Girl suffering from bad Finger, She promised to be Baptized, and wanted me to officiate

I took my shoes to be mended, did not have them till next day, Sat 16th. I went round to good many Houses, gave many Tracts a way, sold one BK of *Ann*, after dinner I started off, Bro Thos gave me 2 Shillings. I called in good many Places on the Road, Stayed good while at the Wickwedge, with Mr Evans, had Tea there, called at a Farm House, was well received, talked long time, Mr Jones came with me half a mile, promised to try to have me ^{at} the School House to Preach in, called in other Houses, and arrived home late, Sun 17th.

I was suffering from a bad cold, stayed to Home in the morning, and wrote my Journal, I took walk in the Evening long with Tom Bowen up to *Wicks* & *Bedw*.

Mon 18th. I was not able to go anywhere for the cold, that was upon me.

Tue 19th. Again to day, I suffer pretty bad, I only went up to the Post Office

Wed 20th. I took a walk in the After Noon Crosgwenllian one of the Farms close by. I remained until Evening, I sold them the Book *Ann*, was very kindly treated. Thur 21st. I remained Home all day, was not nearly well. I received a

Letter from my Wife, was very thankful to find that they were well, and getting long nicely. Frid 22nd. I received two Letters from Henry my Bro, S^c City.

I took a walk in the Evening to Parkybadw, had Tea there, I felt very weak.

Sat 23. I felt much improved. I went with my female *Thos* to *Stammon*, with the Cow to the Fair. He did not sell her, so I returned home with her, stayed home

the remainder of the day. Sun 24th. I remained home all day, devoting my time to reading and writing.

Mon 25th. I remained at Home in the morning, felt little better to day, wrote a Letter to Wife, Received Card from Bro Morse, stating that would call and see me in a day or two. I took a walk to see some of the Farmers

to give them some Tracts, and to show and speak of the BK of *Ann*, I first went to *Curniant*, they were very kind to me, they made me stop and have some Tea.

I showed the Lady the BK, was very much impressed of its virtuous qualities would me to bring it up again some time so the Husband would have a chance to see it. I gave her Tract, said she had much pleasure in reading what I had given her before. I went from there to *Stood* & *Rhiv*, gave them some Tracts, was offered something to eat, from them to *Fynon Rhyderch*, I was kindly treated spoke to

Mr Jones long time, Boar My testimony to Him, Gived Him Tracts, And He read concerdance
of the B.M., And finally Bought it. Then I returned towards home, called in at Cumnant,
eat-Supper there, and came Home. Tus 26th. I caught Cold the day before, was not well all
day, in the Morning I went over to Llanybythier with Tom, to help him with the Pigs
in the After Noon, Bro Jones came by, was glad to see him, went up to Drapach with
him, and returned Home. Wen 27th. I remained home in the Morning Bro Jones came down,
went little walk together after dinner, In the Evening we went up to the Church with
the wabors, and returned to the Mill House where there were a meeting held as a custom before
the day of the Funnal (A Lady there dead) We did not have the chance to speak, for the
Clergy was presiding. Thur 28th. Attended the Funnal, and came Home to dinner,
Bro Jones going to Lampeter, I gave Him 6 pence. Friday 29th. I stayed at Home in
the Morn having bad Head ache, wrote some, and a Letter to Bro Brough Merthyr.
Sat 30th. I did not leave the House untill Evening, not been nearly well,
Sunday 30th. I remained to home all day, it being very cold, I feel better
to day. Mon, April 1st. I went over to Llanybythier with uncle Thoos,
I also saw the Doctor, said that it was indigestion was the matter with
me gave me Bottle full of something to take 4 times a day, cost 1. 6. while
in Llanybythier, I was stoped and questioned in regard to our belief, I
gived them many Tracts, and answered many questions, there came large
crowd to gether to see and hear what was going on, they were lot of
young Preachers that was in the Grammar School. I came Home early, and
help Tom to put in five Potatoes in the garden. Tus 2nd. I wrote a Letter
Henry My Bro, and received One from Home, they being all well, I also
received Letter from Bro Brough, I remain Home all day. Wen 3rd. I
stayed home all day help Tom to fix the fence in the Morning, it turn
to Rain very hard, I received Letter from Mr Taylor, Swansea, stating
that the Photo of my Wife and Babys, were finished (Printed) I
wrote them to keep it untill I should call. Thus 4th. I stayed in the
House all day, except going to a wabor to get some Salve to put on my Face

Frid 5th, I was in the House all day, had my Forehead covered up, likewise Sat the 6th
 Sunday 6th, my Face was much better, I remained in the House untill Evening, when
 I took little walk up to the Post-man, ^{Mon 8th} I felt pretty well, wrote and send a
 Letter to my Wife, I also visited Park J Bedw, had a pleasant chat with Gwenno and
 Sarah her daughter, had Tea there in the evening I went up to a Place called Cwmant
 talked considerable with the Family, about the Sign of the times, and the restoration of the
 Gospel, the Wife wanted the Book of Mor, but the Husband did not have Faith enough, I
 left good impression upon them, was requested to come again, Tues 9th. Another Rainey day, I
 was sound home in the morning, went up to the Post. And also to Hos Hughes, looked
^{over} our old Garden, saw much change in the Trees and everything in general
 nothing so pleasant as used to be with Father, I went to the House and chatted
 with Tom all the evening, He acknowledge that he had nothing against our Religion
 only that he had not swade up his mind to join. Wen 10th. I took a walk and
 visited some of the Nabors, I may say that I help to take the Potatos out of the Pits
 in the morning, Davis Bowen was down after some Potatos, so I stayed and helped
 I visited good many Families, collected some Money, which were for the BK of Mor,
 I also gived away many Tracts, had the promise of the prevelage to hold Meeting
 in one House, the People felt well toward me and the Work, came Home late. Thurs 11th.
 My Uncle wanted that I should go with him to en' Action! good long ways off,
 Raining pretty hard all day, we had very bad Road to travel, Muddy no name for
 it, worst I ever saw. He bought a Cow, we brought her Home late, wet and Muddy.
 Frid 12, I did not leave home, I tried to get some of the Wind off my cloths, and rested, wrote
 a Letter to Bro Morris, and send him the Money, I will state that last Tuesday I sent
 Money off for the Wool, to make a Pair of Blankets, and also a dress for Lottie, Sat 13th
 I was not far away in morning, wrote a Letter to Bro J. D. Evans, In the After-noon
 I went up to Llanwrnon, I had Tea with Mr Evans Store Keeper, gaved him the
 Desert News, I visited another Family there, and also the Shoe Shop, I then took
 down towards Llanybyther, I visited a Family in the Road talked to them considerable
 about the treatment our People have had, while in the States, how they were driven into the Mountains

and settled in the Rocky Mountains, while it was under the Mexican Government, and
 a dry and barren Country it was, I spoke to them of the treatment we have had, and do have
 from the hand of Government, and how the Lord has prospered us, until the Eye of all the
 Nations is upon us, and that the Lord had establish His Church never more to be thrown down
 and that we were sending Missionary to all parts of the World, to call all men to repentance, and
 to teach them the Gospel, They bought the Bk of Mormon, and offered something to eat, and
 thanked me for calling, I went on further and talked to People and gave them some Tracts
 and worked my way home. Sun 14th was home in the morning, wrote a letter, was cold,
 I went up to the Old Church in afternoon to attend their School, very few, they wanted me to
 give out a Hymn and close the School, was invited to come out to Sea, went from there
 to the 6 o'clock Meeting at Drefach Chappel, and home, Mon 15, I was at home in the morning
 wrote a Letter to Bro Brough, I also received Letter from him, and One from my Dear
 David, S L City, I took a walk in the afternoon and remain with Thos Hughes, was in the
 Garden with him, had Tea with him, and I showed him the Book of Mor, read considerable of it
 liked it very much, said for me to come again some day, Tues 16th This morning there appeared very
 strang Phenomena in the Sky, in the like of two Sun's, One was very Red, and the other
 very bright. I took after dinner over towards Llangbyther, did not know where
 I would go, turned one side on the Road and asked the Lord to dictate me
 to where I could do the best good &c, I was directed to go to the Farms called
 Dale y cha, and Dole Cenol, I met with much favour, was very kindly
 received in hairste places, in the first named Place, I sold the Book of
 Mormon, remained long time in the other Place, had Tea there, and left
 some Tracts, and returned home. Wed 17th I did not accomplish very much
 this day, remained about home all day, helped Tom in the Garden, while, in
 the evening I went up to Drefach, had pleasant chat with Thos Hughes,
 spoke to him about the restoration of the Gospel, and boar strong testimony to
 the diversity of Mormonism, He is inclined to believe the Gospel, but hard to
 through off the old idea that the Church is not right, Thur 18th I went over to
 Llangbyther, called in on the Road, and talked to Pearson long time, but He is a person

That has no faith, could not make very much impression on him, I went
 over to the Station, met Bro J D Evans, I found the Wool there, paid 8 pence
 for the carriage, then I came home with Bro Evans, I took nearly 4 pounds of the
 Wool to Llanwern Park & Bedw, as it dayed to dark blue, I stayed there good while,
 came down to the Mill, chatted there a while and came home. ^{1th} Frid 19, Bro Evans
 came down, and we went up the country to gather, called in many Places, was
 pretty well received, had something to eat at Penlan Isa, the were bussey poting in
 Potatos, spoke about having meeting in Penlan Fach that Evening, we went up there
 spoke to the Old Talks about it they were very willing, so word was sent round to
 nabors, we went up to the New Court our selfs, told some of ralitives of the Old Talks
 of the meeting. Then we returned to Penlan Fach, had something to eat, and had
 good time untill meeting commenced, wich took place 20 Minutes to 8 o Clock, I spend
 the meeting by Prayer, and Bro Evans spoke, occupied 25 Minutes, and then I spoke some
 half an hour, we had good meeting, the Lord was with us through His Spirit, we spoke
 with much force, and bore strong Testimony, they felt they were without an excuse
 I came home alone, Bro Evans stayed at Penlan Isa. ^{7th} Sat 20 I was home in the
 Morning, done some writing, Bro Evans came down and we started up to Llanwern,
 made some inquirie in regard to the time of meetings there found that there were no meeting
 6 o clock Sun Evening, therefore we gave out notice, to the effect that we would
 hold meeting Sunday Evening 6 o'clock, we visited good werry Family's round
 there, gave away some Tracts, we started on our way towards New Court, called
 at a Ralitives of Bro Evans, were very kindly received had Tea, and pleasant
 chat with them, then we proceeded on our journey, soon arrived in Court, spent most
 of the time with the Blacksmiths, arrange to have our appointments out in the Chapel
 Sunday, that we would hold our meeting Tues Evening 7, 30, then we returned home.
 Sunday 21. ^{21st} Very stormy in the Morning, I remained to home all day, untill 4 30,
 when I started for Llanwern, called by Bro Evans, and went on, arrived in good time
 got the Key and fix things ready, meeting commenced 6 30, we gave out 4 ymn and the
 People started to sing, I Prayed, Bro Evans spoke about 30 Minutes, I spoke 60 Minutes,

had good Meeting, there was two questions asked concerning the Plates of the
 Bre of Mr, and the character of the 3 Witnesses, I took pains to explain them,
 good order prevailed, then we came home, Mon 22nd, I wrote a Letter to my Bro
 David, and remained ^{home} all day, Partis were putting my Uncle's Grain in, and I was
 round with them some, Tues 23rd, Rained hard in the Morning, and I remained home, in the
 afternoon I took up to Park & Bedw, had pleasant time there, and came home and made
 ready to go to New Court, to fill the Apointments, it storm'd with me on the Road terrible
 hard, I arriv'd in time met Bro Evans there, went to the Store bought some candles, got
 the Key, and proceeded to the Meeting House, People were very late coming to gether, 8, 20
 when Meeting commenc'd, we gave out Hymns and the Men commenc'd to Sing, good singing
 I introduced Bro Evans, He spoke little over half an hour, and I spoke about the same
 length of time, There were some little laughing going on among the young folks, but we
 maintained order, the Lord help us to speak that made some of them to stbor up, it
 was late when I arriv'd home, Wen 24th, Another Cold and wet day, I went up in the
 morning and walk'd a ways with Bro Evans, He were going to Lanfster, I done some
 writing, in the afternoon I visit'd a Nabor, talk'd to him his duty, that he should obey
 the Gospel, now while he has the privelege, explain'd the necessity of working for the bread, He is
 very favorable inclin'd to the Gospel, Tues 26th, I received Letter from Home, I learn'd that one
 of the Little Boy's had been pretty sick, and also my Wife had been ailing considerable
 but were all better now, I spent most of the day in writing to my Wife, and remain'd
 to home, Frid 26th, Nothing particular hapend this day, it being cold and stormy, I
 remain'd round home untill Evening, when I took little walk and visit'd a Family
 kept the Mill, pass'd the time in general conversation, with very pleasant feeling.
 Sat 27th, I fix'd little of my clothes, wrote a Letter to Mr Taylor at Swansea, it
 being wet and cold, remain'd at home Evening, when I visit'd some Nabor, stay'd
 a while at Park & Bedw, and return'd home, Sun 28th, Another of the usual days
 Rainy and cold, I spent most of the day in reading and writing, and sattisfied
 to home, where I remain'd all day, Mon 29th, This being little better day, I made
 ready to start out, I went by way of Lanfster and down towards Lanllenni

May

called in many places talked and gave away many Tracts to the People
 sold One Book of Mormon to Mr David Harris, Dolgor, made a acquaintance
 of many People, and I think spend up some places to preach at, went down to
 Lloyns Riv. where Margaret, my Cousin, lives, stayed all night, and was well
 treated. Tus 30th, I started off about 9 o'clock, went over to Lambingel Scroth,
 visited a Family, and spent the time in a pleasant chat, and left a Tract, promised
 to call again, called at a carpenter Shop, talked of my Mission, to the inmates, and
 gave them to read some of the Book of Mor, left some Tracts, I then went on the
 Road towards Landysul to a Place called the Lodge, where the People that is related
 to the Stephens, (Malbad) lives. had dinner there, left them some Tracts,
 with the promise to go back to preach if they would find a place, which they
 promised to do. I then worked my way to see an Old Gentleman, which had
 been married to Father Sister. called at a House called Cottage, to shelter from
 storm, was kindly received, Sold Bk of Mor and left some Tracts, I then
 called at Glyn Coch, where a relative of mine lives, had Tea, and proceeded to
 find my Uncle. He lives at a Place called Garret. found him enjoying good health
 after I told him who I was, He was well pleased, we went down together to the
 village, called Pencader, visited the Old Lady's Grave, my Aunt Father Sister
 and we also visited his Son, Family, they were very kind to me, they made me
 stop and Eat. (that is Lady of the House was kind, the Husband was out at Home)
 She promised me place to sleep any time I would come down. We then went
 back to the Garret and there I stayed all Night. Wen, May 1st. I bid my Uncle
 good by, about 10 o'clock, went down to Pencader, visited the Factory, and
 promised to call in the afternoon, I then called at my Cousin House few minutes
 she wanted me to be sure and call when I would come down, I next visited the
 Taylors, spent little time with them, and went over to a farm House to see a
 Sister to my Aunt - Sally Kilcurn, I ate dinner with them (Tales and
 Butter Milk) had good time in talking together. Gave them Tracts, and spoke of
 the restoration of the Gospel, they were very kind wanted I should call again. I

went back again to the Taylors, spoke there long time about Utah, and the Church, made favorable impression upon them, left them, and called at the Factory stayed and talked there long time. Mr. Thos Davis, bought Bk of Mors, and was favorable to us, they made me stop and have some Tea, I started on my return home, called at Clyn Cook a cording to agreement; then went on my way to Llyn Pen, I stoped there for a while, they gave me something to eat; and started for home, which I reached before 9 o'clock. Thur 2nd, I wrote a Letter to Bro Brough in the morning, and in the afternoon I helped to fill Manuar that was hoald to the field to plant Potatos, we worked untill late, I was tayerd.

Frid 3^d, I remained at home in the evening, and rested, I went round little in the afternoon. Sat 4th, I sent off some Desert News to diffeant ones, took a walk to Lanunen, called in a House on the Road, explained some of the Principles of the Gospel, I did not get to see the Pearson that I wanted at Lanunen then I came home another way, called at House where they were owing me for the Book of Mors, left them the Desert News, I called at diffeant Houses and gave the People some Tracts, and explained concerning the Bk of Mors, and came home, Sun 5th, I remained in the House all day writing and reading, but in the Evening I took a walk visited a Pearson, spoke to him concerning his duty, to believe in the Gospel and be saved, read to him from the Book of Mors Boase My testimony to him, he felt first-rate. Mon 6th, I visited Park of Bedw in the morning, then I helped Tom to rake some stones together in the Hay field, we were at it all day, Tues 7th we continued to clean the Hay field untill late, though I took little walk before dark. Wen 8th I went up to Lampeter with my Uncle, helped to drive some stock up to the Fair he sold one Cow, I met Bro Morse there, I eat dinner at Bro Phos, and soon after dinner, I brought some of the stock home, (myself) I brought one Anomal, part of the way, that belonged to another party, he gave me one Shilling (25^{cent}) I remained to home the remainder of the day, Thur 9th, I wrote a Letter to Phos Phos at Palgareq to enquire in regard to the preveladge to hold meeting down there.

a Letter to Bro Leigh, in Penbrockshire, Irid 17th. I prepared to start for Talgarreg, Bro Morse and myself waited until the Post-came, I received Letter from Bro Henry, S L City, we then started in the Rain and it continued to Rain all the way, 7 or 8 Miles, we called in to see a weaver on the Road, stayed with him quite a while, He made us stop to have some Tea, we then went on, much warmer, we arrived in due season, was made very comfortable at the Place of Lodging, with Mr. Proth & Wife, it being so rainy the People could not come together we got some Candles, and first things ready, few came, and was anxious for us to hold Meeting, so we told them we would hold short-Meeting, I opened the Meeting, Bro Morse spoke 30 Minutes, I spoke 20 Minutes, and dismissed, we had very pleasant-time at the Lodging, Sat¹⁸ we gave them orders for suits of Cloths a Peace, they only charge us 6 Pence a Peace for Lodging, we left with the understanding that we could call in about Month, we called at House on the way home got some Dinner, then we came alright - but before we reached home we had very hard rain, we rested for while, and started off for Penworn reach there before dark, found the Falks all well, we stayed there all Night Sun¹⁹ and started off for Gylt Lodogon, where there were Meeting appointed it being very fine day lots of People came together, Meeting commenced 2^o 50, I commenced the Meeting, Bro Morse spoke for some time, then I followed for a little while. There were not very good feeling there, good many laughing, I came Home by Llanlluney, called at Llwynpur, they gave me some Tea, and proceeded homeward, I was invited to ride in a Cart for 2 Miles. Mon 20th, I remained round home all day, wrote considerable, wrote a Letter to Bro Bough, I us 21st I started to clean the Wool and pick it: Tom helped me, in the afternoon I went up to New Court, visited few of the Pople gave away few Tracts, came home late, New 22nd I healed the Falks at the Potatoes, braking Clouds, and fixed up

the Rows, worked hard, and was very tired, at Night. ^dThurs 23.
 I made ready and started for Mudroilin, I called a Place, called
 Hafod, eat Dinner there, they were acquainted with Father and
 Mother. I reached Mudroilin early in the afternoon, found Capt Lewis &
 Family all well, stayed with them, thFrid 24, I started for Llanarth,
 had some Rain on the Road, stayed at the Stone for a while, and went
 and saw Mr Rees, the School Master, gave him some Tracts and the
 Desert News, showed him the Book Program, but would not buy,
 made arrangement with him to get the School House, I also called at
 Mr Lewis the Fullum and Cloth Maker, was kindly received, had Tea
 with them, stayed again at the Stone, and also with a Shoemaker
 and came back to Mudroilin. thSat 25, Started back to Maesfelin
 called at Blaynear Llanerog, and then came through Dewi, had
 arrived from Utah, night before, was very lonesome, but well, I received
 Letter from Bro Brough, we took a walk up to Park y Bedw, stayed there
 for a while, and returned to Maesfelin. thSund 26, we started up to
 Lampeter, found the Falks all well, were very kindly received, stayed all
 day, we took a walk up to see the Tower, some 3 miles distant. thMon 27,
 we remained at Lampeter, I visited few folks, and walk round
 some. thTues 28, we started after Breakfast down to Llanbyther, we called
 there, in few Houses, gathered little information as to Dewi's Relatives,
 and came to Maesfelin, found there were Letter from J L Edwards
 Willard, I wrote Letter to my Wife. thWen 29, Raining, I took Dewi
 round to see difant Places where his Father used to be when a Boy.
 I made arrangement for Dewi to stay with Hughes, Uncle Thomas said
 he could not keep him. I started to write to ^{J L Davis} ~~J L~~, thwent up to see Dewi
 before night. thThurs 30, I finish writing to ^{J L Davis} Edwards, we did not go
 far, very wet day, we went up to Park y Bedw in the afternoon, and
 return home. thFrid 31, I first to start off, Dewi came down, and we started.

June

Called at Penwern, had some Tea, and sister Evans gave me some money 6 pence, she were very kind, then we went on down to Lwynypion Margaret received us very kindly, stayed there all Night. Sat 1st, we started for Carmarthen walked all the way. we were kind of tired, we hunted round Town for the Falks that Dewi wanted see, we found them, so we parted, Dewi was to go with them so he could see all the Falks, I went round Town hunting for some other Falks, found one man that has been in the Church for 30 years, He gave me something to eat, and walk round Town with me, and introduced me to several ones, I then started out for Lwynfilltir Fach, to Bro & Sister Jones, stayed all Night. Sun 2nd, I stayed with the Old Falks untill Monday Morning, B. I in company with Bro Jones started for Carmarthen, it being Fair day, we traveled through and through, I was in hopes to see Dewi, but failed, I started out of Town about one o'clock, walked 8 miles and took the Train for Llangbyther, and came home, done some writing, Tues 4th, I wrote a Letter to Brother Henry, J L City, I went round some, received the Desert News, Wen 5th, I took a walk up to Llanmunn, saw few Families, and spend the afternoon with Mr & Mrs Davis, I talked great eye to him about the restoration of the Gospel, read some of the Book of Hemmon, gave all the information that was necessary concerning the Plan of Salvation, then came direct home, wrote a little, Thur 6th, I remained round untill noon, then went round to good many Farm Houses, gave away errary Tracts, came home late, Frid 7th, I went off in another direction, to Landyar, called at good many Houses, and Tract every where, went on towards the Mountain to the south from Landyar, returned by Gurdybock, had Tea at Lantren Fawr, made some new friends in that part. Sat 8th, I wrote a Letter to J L & in the morning, and in the afternoon I went up to the Greave yard, and fixt the Head some of one of my little Brothers Grave and spend the remainder of the day in company with Uncle Phos, visiting. Sun 9th, I remained at Home all day, reading and writing.

Monday 10th I attended the Church, to hear the different Schools
 reciting and Singing, Received a Letter from Home, were all pretty well.
 Tues 11th I went up to Lampeter to see Miss Margaret Thomas, returned in
 time to attend funeral in the Afternoon, Prepared things ready for to
 start towards Merthyr. Wen 12th I started off in the Morning, by way of
 Llanybythar, called at different Houses on the Road, had something to Eat at
 Caermlaw, I sold Book of Mor at Rhyd Cwmerey, at Hancawil, I called
 to see David Davis my old playmate (Taylor) He gave me something to
 Eat, after resting I went on my way, went by Llanillycherr, and Clean
 my Mother's Grave, called at Cumbri, had Glass of Milk, went on up
 to Foesddu, found the Falcks all well, was welcomed there, stayed all Night.
 Thur 13th I made several call round the Nabor's during the Morning, was
 welcomed every where, then I started for Llangathen, to get the Age of
 Henry Griffiths old friend, then I went on my way cross the Lelli Ogor
 Park to Llanybriem, there I took the Train for Pont ar Dulais, stopt
 at Jenkin, Frid 14th I started of on foot to Swensen, called to see
 Shadrach Jones Grave, in Swensen, I called at Taylor the Painter, or
 Photographer, received the Oil Photo of my wife and Babys, then I took
 the Train for Merthyr, found few of the Elders there, all well. Sat 15th we
 had Council at 2 o'clock, had good time, I was appointed to meet
 Bro Teasdale with two or three others, at 6, 30, everything went on
 smooth. Bro Teasdale arrived, we had another Council until half
 past 9 o'clock, had much good instruction from Bro Teasdale. Sun 16th
 Meeting commenced 10 30, few of the Brethren spoke in Welsh, had good
 time, Meeting commenced in the Afternoon at 2 o'clock, I was
 appointed to see to the Sacrament, and helped in administer it. We
 had good Meeting, again at 6 o'clock Meeting commenced, we had very good
 Meeting, every body felt good, we spent the Day very pleasant, and had
 pleasant time with Bro Teasdale after Meeting. Mon 17, we again met in

a meeting capacity each one received our appointments for the ensuing month, Bro Tisdale started for Liverpool 2 o'clock, I writ^d a letter to my wife in the afternoon, nothing of importance occurred, Tues 18th, I remained in Marthyr all day, waited on Miss Margaret Thos. She been pretty sick, in the Evening she got better, I, in company with Bro Morse went down to Pentre Bach, with Miss Thos, she was to be Baptized, we waited untill after dark, then I changed my clothes, put on some old rags went down into the water and Baptized her, Bros Morse & Brough being witnesses, after we change again, Sister Thos was confirmed by Bro Morse, Bro Brough and myself came up to Marthyr. Wed 19th, Good many of the Brethren started to their several places of Labor, Sister Thos also started Home, I settled up every thing in office, and prepared to start back to the country, Bro Brough came with me a ways, we then parted, with warm affection, it being 11 to 12, when 11 miles I turned in to^d House, and the woman made^d some Tea; I was very dry, the next Place I reached was Defynog, here I remained over Night - paid 1.4, Thur 20th, I started off for Cilcwm, reached Landoverly 1. o'clock called at White-Swan to^o the Lady of the House, she being an old acquaintance of Father & Mother, she gave me good dinner, I called for a Glass of Beer, and started on, called in a House and got some Milk to drink reached Cilcwm, all right, stayed over Night with Mary Bowen my Cousin, Fri 21st, I went up to Abarrhayad to see the Falls, remained there all day, and back to Cilcwm in the Evening, Sat, 22nd, crossed the Country to Ceio, called in several Houses, and got some Milk, and Bread and Butter, came to Camnant^{where}, David Bowen lives, stayed all night, Sun 23^d, I remained there all day, with the exception of visiting one of the Neighbours, and had some Tea there, and a pleasant chat, Mon 24th, I started in company with Eliza Bowen

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for Lampeter, I stayed there for a while, rested, and had something to Eat, in the after Noon I came down to Maesyfelin, found them all well, and a Letter from my Wife waiting me. She being not very well and also the Little Boys not very well, I done some writing. Tus 25th, I went up and helped Phos Hughes at the Hay, worked hard all day, Bro Morse came down from Lampeter, we made arrangement to start for Talgareg next-day. Wen 26th, I wrote a Letter to Bro Brough, and made ready to start for Talgareg, we went by way of New Court, called in Farm-House and got all the Butter Milk we wanted to drink, reached Talgareg early, stayed with Mr Phos, Green Grove, and were welcomed there. Thur 27th, we stayed in the House in the Morning, fitted our clothes, in the Afternoon we went for walk, called in several Houses gave them some Tracts, and notified the People that we would hold meeting in Talgareg that evening, went as far as Esger Onwe we were highly welcomed there, had something to Eat there, and was invited to come again. we held our Meeting in the School House, good Congregation, and good Spirit, we were well satisfied. Frid 28th, I had New Pants, to put on, and after waiting for the Post to come in, we started Home, reached in time for Tea, I changed my clothes, and went up to Parky Bedw, to give them little help at the Hay. Sat 29th, I went up to Parky Bedw and worked all day at the Hay, got it all in. Sun 30th, I went up to Lampeter with the intention to have meeting, but was disappointed, through Sister going away, I also received a Letter from Father, I remained in Lampeter all day, Mon July 1st, I made ready to come to Maesyfelin Bro Thomas gave 2 Shillings to me, for Pocket money. I got the Privilege to ride down in a Bugy, belonged to Bro Phos arrived in here, about 10, 20, helped to scater the Hay untill noon, when Uncle asked me, if I should go and help one of the Nabors,

so I did, helped Lewis Davis (the Miller) worked hard all the Afternoon
 and in the Evening done considerable writing. I also send a Letter
 of to My Wife, Tuesnd. I worked at the Hay in Maesyfelin all day,
 Wen^{3^d}. I helped to setten the Hay at Dolwen in the Morning a
 while, and the remainder of the day was at Maesyfelin, we had the Hay
 all in, Thur^{4th}. I helped to pay my Uncle debt, by going over to Dolwen
 and worked all day haying. Frid^{5th}. I again worked at the Hay in
 Dolwen, Sat^{6th}. was to Home in the Morning, Jobing round, in
 the Afternoon I went down to a Place called Gladwesth, helped
 them all the Afternoon Picking Hay to the Stack, and was very tired.
 got Home later Sun^{7th}. I started down to a Place called Pant Fawc
 about 8 Miles off, to fill en a pointment, - was to meet Broo
 Morse & Morris there, but we met before we reached there, we
 were disappointed in finding no one to Home, therefore we did not
 have any Meeting, Broo Morris left us here, he going to a Place called
 Pant y Bwdram to see the old Man, he being the Father of David
 Jones, which is in St John, Malad, Broo Morse & myself returned
 back, we called and stayed a while at Llynon Pur, we enjoyed some
 Tea, for we had no dinner, then we came on, I arrived Home before
 dark, went round with Broo Morse, to see the Hughes at Cumbout.
 Mon^{8th}. I helped to take the Cow to the Ball, and had to considerable
 running, in the Afternoon I helped the Fawks to fix the Hay Stack
 round Little in the Evening, Tues^{9th}. I went up in the Morning to
 see Daniel Davis (Tylor) He cut my Hair, after dinner I went
 over to Larry Lythur, got a promised of Hall to hold Meeting in, call
 in few Places, and came Home, (Raining) Wen^{10th}. I went
 up in the Morning to Drefach, and while there Broo Morse came from Talgarth
 he came down to Maesyfelin, and had dinner, then we went up to the
 Dress Maker (Mary Davis Pant y Cloethys.) to get the Blankets,

but Our sorrow, she was not at Home, we found where she was
 and I went after her, Got the Key, to the House, and also the Blankets,
 then we came down to Mac & Felin, and soon started for Llangbyther
 Bro Morse was going to Merthyr, He got new Box at Llangbyther, then
 we went to the Sta, there we parted, I returned Home, Thurs 11th, I
 started off to the Country, over beyond Rhyd y Bont, to visit a Lady
 that had been kind to me, she received me kindly, remained with her
 considerable time, she made me Eat, and listen to all I had to say to her, I
 read to her Merry Passages from the Book of Job, and was deeply effected
 I bore my testimony, and also told her not mind the World, to come forward and
 serve the Lord, and as I turned to leave her she cried. I came strait Home,
 I helped the Falkes to clean the Swales (Roolebegs) in the Evening,
 Frid 12th, I helped the Falkes in the Field until we got through, I received
 to Day Letter from my wife, all well. Sat 13th, I went over to meet the
 Train, for I had been sought for that Bro H. H. Thomas was to come and
 labor with me. He arrived, we then went round to see about Lodging Place
 He had made engagement with one Lady, and after while she said that she
 had changed her mind, that he had better hunt another Place, because he being
 a Gorman, but it came out all right; he found another Place and a better one.
 we gave out an Appointment to Preach there (at Llangbyther) on Sunday 21st
 and then we went up to Place called Llanwen, and gave out an Appointment
 to Preach there Sun 14th, 6 o'clock, then we ~~both~~ returned Home. Sun 14th, I
 was home all day until 4 o'clock, when I started for Llanwen to fill
 the appointment. I met Bro Thomas there we had pretty fair Meeting, held in
 the School House, I spoke first, occupied 30 minutes, Bro Thomas spoke very
 well, 30 minutes, made favorable impression upon few of them, we gave
 out another appointment in two weeks. Bro Thos accompanied me Home,
 Mon 15th I wrote a Letter to my wife, after dinner I went over to
 Llangbyther, Bro Thos and my self went up to Penyvern to see the

Falks, after spending the afternoon, we came home, Tues 16th, I wrote
 a Letter to Bro Brough, and then I went up to Llanuwern to Bro Thos
 according to appointment. Then we started up to the Creben, about the Houses
 on the way, we made an appointment for Thurs Night, then proceeded
 further to the Felinack, gave an appointment there for Frid Night,
 then we started up for Lampeter, we reached there by 7 o'clock, tired
 and Hungry, I had nothing to eat since 6 o'clock in the morning, we
 were welcomed at Lampeter, Then 17th, we started down to Hanybryther
 Bro John Thos, gave ^{us} 2 Shilling a piece, we called at House by Hanybryther
 to see some acquaintances, we were very kindly received, they made us to
 eat little something, and gave us lot of Gooseberries to eat, we went through
 the Fair to see what was going on, then we rested at Bro Taffs Lodging
 Place, and I came Home, Thurs 18th, I wrote a Letter to Bro Brough, and
 was ready to go the Creben to fill an appointment; I met Bro Thomas
 Llanuwern, we had time on the Road, reached in due time, we commenced meeting
 15 past 8, the People late coming, had pretty fair meeting, and good order, we
 stopped over Night at a House close by, Paid 1, a piece, Frid 19th, we went up to
 Bichewid, called at Pantrewfach, to see for the School House, was very
 kindly received, Mrs Evans made us eat some Bread & Chees & Porter, Had
 chat with Her, then we saw Mr Davis, he said he would give out appointment
 through the Children, but condended against our doctrine, we then on down
 to Kellea Park, we went to see Mr Jenkins, Pont-Fan, we went into
 the House, the Maide gave us Glass of Milk a piece, went down to the Field
 and got Mr Jenkins permission of the House, we then returned to School House
 saw Mr Jones the School Master, we gave out appointment for Thursday
 Night 7 30 P M, we then went up ^{to} Iestrad, to fill in Appointment,
 Meeting commenced 8, 15, quite a few came together, but there was one man
 that was very annoying, would dispute, and caused considerable disturbance
 we stopped over Night in a Tavern, 1 a piece, Sat 20th, we wrote some

Cards, one for Lanarth, and one for Mydroilin, that we would hold meeting the respective Places, Lanarth Wenstag 24, Mydroilin Frid 26 then we started towards Home, I reached home 3 o'clock, Received Letter from John My Bro, with a draft of £10 in it, Sun 22nd, I remained home untill Evening, when I started over to Glambyther, to hold meeting, we had little trouble in finding the Key of the Room, few People went Home, meeting commenced 7.40, I opened the meeting, Bro Thomas Preach first, 35 minutes, I Preached 25 minutes. Bro Evans, of Penwern spoke little while, he caused considerable feelings to arise, most of People went out before we could close, owing to him, There were very large crowd came together. Bro Thomas came part of the way home with me, Mon 23rd, I staid home in the morning wrot a Letter to Father, I went up to Mrs Jones My Cousin, 'Parp G Bedus' she being sick, stayed with her long time, called at cwm Bont, talked to the Falks there for a while and returned home, Tues 24th, I remained home reading untill after dinner when I made ready to start off, to fill appointments, Bro Thomas called by 2 o'clock and we started, I called at Dr Lewis Store brefast, to have check change he payed me the money without charge, we went on our way, called on the way and had Glass of Senger Beer given us, called also, at my Uncle Jenkins, and reached Deheuid early, went down Pent G Rhew to see the Falks, They told us to come and sleep there that Night, the heard Girl was not well, meeting commenced 8 o'clock, Bro Thomas spoke first, and most of the time, we had good meeting, good singing, we went down to Pantrew, and stayed all night, Wen 25th we had good night rest, we remained with the Falks, untill late, it being very rainy, we went on our way to Lanarth, called in a Shoe Maker Shop and had nice talk with People. Stopped at Mydroilin, and reached Lanarth early, called to see Family in Town, and had good chance of testifier of the restoration of the Gospel, we went on and engage Lodging, and prepared for the meeting, but the People did not come

in time to commence in time so we had to agone, there were meeting in one
 of the Meeting Houses, and it was wet evening, we had supper, and retired, Thurs
 25th, we had ^{good} Bedd, and good Breakfast, it being very Rainey we concluded to
 stay until 4 o'clock, after Tea, we started off for Celeste Bark, we had
 good many on the way, reached there in good time, People commenced to come
 had good House full, and had good time, good spirit, much freedom to speak
 to them, One of the men knew me, came up and shook hands, was glad to see
 me, wanted us to go and have something to eat, but we had long ways to go
 that night to a Lodging place, and beged to be excused, said that if we should
 come again, we would be provided for with him, we reached our loging
 place, and retired, Fridth 26, we rested very well, after Breakfast Bro
 Thomas wrote a letter to his Wife, we started for Mydroilin, talked to
 man on the way concerning Religion, and it grew hot, he being not a
 believer, we arrived erly, Capt Lewis received us kindly, took us up to his
 House and gave us something to eat, Mrs Lewis told us to be contented that
 she had made arangement for our Bedd, in her Mother's House, that was
 comfort to us, we made ready, and got everything arange for the meeting,
 The People came late, after 8 o'clock they came and meeting commenced
 Bro Thos and myself doing the singing, not very good, I commenced the meeting
 Bro Thomas spoke first, and I occupy the remainder of the time we bough
 had much freedom to speak to the People, very large crowd, after supper
 we retired, Sat 27th, after Breakfast we went round to see ~~the~~ some
 of those that favored us, and thanked them, we then came to Capt Lewis
 and after I gave Mrs Lewis the Book of Mr, for Present, we commenced
 to talk to them about it, all the folks listened with mark attention,
 the Spirit of the Lord was there, we then bid them adue, and steard towards
 Home, we turned in to Bro Thos Davis, (Fainog) had little something to
 eat, and came on, arrived home erly, and were glad to have little rest.
 Sun 28th, I started off to ^{meet} Bro Thom according to apointment, we met

August-

at Llanuwern, we then went on to Lampeter, Found The Parks enjoying good health. after dinner we commenced our meeting, four of us, and five partook of the sacrament, and spoke and encouraged ourself's and Bro and Sister Thomas, we had very good time, together and after Tea, we made rady to go down to Llanuwern to fill en appointment; Bro John Thos gave us 4 Shilling a pease, in our pocket 2, we arrived at Llanuwern in due season, after resting little while we proceeded to the School House, after while we were accompanied by some people, we commenced our meeting, some of the Girls commenced the singing, I opened the meeting by prayer, Bro Thos spoke for a while but did not receive the spirit to assist him much, I was favored with his aide, and spoke with considerable force, very good meeting, then we returned home, Mon 29th. I remained home and wrote a Letter to my Bro David, and also wrote up my journal; in the afternoon I went over to see Bro Thos, stayed with him for a while, then he came part of the way home with me. Tues 30th. I waited untill untill the Post came, I Received a Letter from my Wife, All well, and doing well, I then went over to Llanybyther, with the understanding that we were going to Llanelli, but instead, we concluded that we had better sent for what things was wanted, to come by Rail. then I wrote a Letter to my Wife, and after that we went up to Bro Evans Penwern, I helped them to get up one lode of Hay, and after we eat Supper we came back, Home. Wen 31st. I remained home in the morning, untill Bro Thos came along, then we went up to Llanced to see Mr Davis, about the Chappel to hold our meeting in, but we did not see him, he being away at the Hay. we went in another direction then to see de part partie, were away all day without anything to eat, did not accomplish what we wanted, and came home. Thur August 1st. I remained at home untill afternoon, Wrote a Letter to John my Bro, and went up to Brebach, and over to

Llangybyther according to appointment, we went to see a Family by the Name of Thomas, we were invited to call, we were received kindly, had the privilege of picking Goosberis, and had something to Eat, and talk to them about joining the church, blessed them and left, we called to see another person by the Name of Jones (Tailor) he had been in our meeting at Llangybyther, and was considerably effected concerning certain doctrine and was glad to see us, asked good many questions, was favorable inclined to all that was explained to him, thanked us for calling, and we parted, Bro Thomas came some distance with me towards my Home. ^{2 mts} I did: I was home fore part of the day, done some reading and writing, I took a walk round Brefach and gave out an appointment, that we would hold meeting out Sunday Evening then I went over to Llangybyther, stayed with Bro Thomas untill Evening.

Sat 3^d I wrote a letter, and done some reading, received some papers from John I took the Game up to Park of Bedew, for Sweeney to see it, stayed there for a while, and concluded to take it up to the Reeve, (Curt of Brodyr,) was told that it was to stout for the purpos intended, but; he would do what he could with it. And returned home. Sun 4th was to home in the Morning, untill Bro Thomas came by. And then I went off with him, we concluded we would Fast untill Supper, I took him round to the Old Church Yard, spent some time there, then we walked over to Maesmeillion, went in to see Bro Jones Talked to him concerning the different Denominations, he confessing that they could not being all right: ever that they could not be but one, they wanted that we should drink cup of Tea, with them. Then we came back to Maesycelin, St. a while, and went on up to Brefach, stayed round untill meeting time, 7, 40 when good many People came to gether, good many thought us disgraceful, and acted shame to acknowledge that they came to meeting, came more for fun. would not come up to where they could sing, only so they could hear. I gave out the Hymns, and announced the meeting, and Bro Thos spoke to them for a while, and it Rained, I held the umbrella above him. I spoke for little while, but it commenced to get late

and some old dogs commenced to play, caused the People to stir and laugh, I
 stoped at wance, thanked them for their kind attention, and asked them to join
 in the Singing of Lord dismiss us with thy Blessing &c. good large crowd.
 we then came home. Mon 5th. I healed Uncle Thomas to drive the Hogs
 over to Slanybyther, to the Market, stayed there untill noon, came home in
 company with John Hughes, spoke to him concerning the Gospel and it's
 blessings, and the consequence of rejecting it. I wrote this journal and stayed
 to home untill Evening. when I took a walk up to Perkybedw, and called at
 Oumbont, and returned home. Tues 6th. I prepared for the Trip to New Quay,
 Bro Phos came by, we started off 9.30. we took the main Road to New Quay.
 called by James Jones Selligron, was nicely treated, and entertained, had good Dinner
 and departed, called at the Store of Penbont Sham, we gave out an appointment to
 hold Meeting Sun 11th, at 6 o'clock. we proceeded on our journey, called to see Sister
 Evans, and continued on, we called and stoped for a while with Mr Phos (Tailor)
 we were blessed with something to Eat. could not make an Appointment for the
 Ford Night, for the Sea party was going to be there, we went on, reached New Quay,
 in due time, had considerable trouble in finding Lodging, the Place was so full of
 People, but we succeeded in getting good place, we was at a house of one Mr Price
 untill late, He oposed our dwelling, but we called to see him several times, and
 was ever well received, Wen 7th. we spend the day in the enjoyment of good
 health, we traveled the Sea shore, considerable distance, I even swam, and Bathed
 had good swim, we returned to our Lodging place at 4 o'clock, and had
 something to eat, we were buying our own vittles, and have the Lady to cook it,
 Thur 8th. This being the day when the Goat Races was to come forth, the People
 commenced to come in from daybreak, untill there were many Thousands, the
 day wore fine, and the sailing commenced about 11 o'clock, there were 8 boats
 competing, 7 Miles race, in a triangle shape. the wind was just right, not
 too rough, and they work well, there were 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes, 4th for the first. The first
 one came in two Hours, and then defraught kinds of Race ^{Boat} Races, all very

interesting, and at close of the day, there were four Buses, in all, it was very
 enjoyable day for me, there also in attendance, very good Band, Fri 9th, we came
 away towards Home, we called at a Farm House, to see the Man, Mr Edwards, we had
 glass of Milk & pease, and gave them some Tracts, and left our testimony with
 them, came on to Talgarey, rested at Mr Thos, had some Tea, and I tried my
 cloths on, they were prely good fit. - Paid him $\text{£} 2$ for the suit, I had also
 Paid him 10^d for the Pants I had from previous to this. He gave I back, we
 came on towards home, we called at Glanbur, had Glass of Milk & Pease, we
 arrived at Maunfelin in good season, Sat 10th, I wrote this journal in the morning
 and read some of the Papers from Utah, in the afternoon I went over to Llanymthor
 stayed a while with Thos, and returned home, Sun 11th. I remained to time until
 3 o'clock, when Bro Thos came, and we started for Penbontshan, we had pleasant
 time on the Road, went into an old quarry and Prayed unto the Lord for his
 aide, that we may be able to discharge our duty, in an acceptable manner, we went
 on found the People commencing to come together, we found Mr Evans, the Stone
 Keeper very kind, we rested little while, when 6 o'clock came we commenced
 the meeting, Bro Thos commenced by Prayer. I gave out another Hymn, and
 spoke for a while, 40 minits, then Bro Thos spoke for a while, the People listen
 with mark atention, the best of order; there were present about 200 people,
 after meeting we were invited in, and Mrs Evans had some Tea prepared to
 us, after conversing while with few that came in, we departed, arrived

 get us the School House to hold meeting, we gave out a pintment for 8
 night, 8 o'clock, and then I returned home, Tues 13th, I remained until
 Bro Thos came over, then we went up to see John Davis, (Preacher) about
 having the litle House to hold meeting, we met him on the Road, had little chat
 with him, and gave his consent, we thanked him, then we went on up to

New Court; We saw Mr Bowen at the School Board. We got him to promised
 give out an appointment through the Children for Tuesday Night. We then
 went up as far as Jenkins Blacksmith Shop. We loaded the folks of the
 Meeting, and then we returned home, I had the Head Ache, all day, Mon 14th.
 I did some little writing in the Morning, started to write to my wife, and then I
 spend considerable time in reading, and I went over to Llanfyllter in
 the evening, it being very wet day, we proceeded up to Pencraig, we were
 pleased to learn that Mr Davis, had procure the S House, and all were
 well, we rested with Mr Davis, had pleasant time, then we went up to the
 S House, had some candles, and lighted up, the People commence to come
 together, Meeting commenced 8 o'clock, I commenced by Prayer, and Bro
 Tho's Preached first, had pretty fair freedom, Spoke for 30 minutes, I
 arose, and spoke for 40 minutes, we were blessed with considerable
 to say, and the People were well pleased, we gave away many Tracts
 at the close, it was 9,30 when we left the house, and some of the Women
 expressed themselves, as well pleased, that they would come again, After
 give Mr Davis parting goodly, we made our way home, being quite late
 10,30 when I arrived. Thur 15th I received Letter from Home, (Utah,)
 stating that my wife was not very well, and also that the little
 Boys was under Cold, but were getting long fine, I also wrote an
~~answer~~ and sent with the returned mail, I then wrote my Journal
 after which Bro Tho's came, when we made our way up to New Court
 we proceeded to get everything ready, and waited for the time, we had
 through it up, only very few came together, we concluded to announce
 that we would hold Meeting Mon Night - in order for the People to get to
 know of it Sunday, we then left for Home, Frid 16th I stayed in the house
 in the Morning, doing some reading, after dinner I went over to Llanfyllter
 Bro Tho's and myself went down Llanllwini, we gave away some Tracts and
 latter to the people concerning Gospel, we also engaged the Blacksmith

Shop for to hold Meeting in, Tuesday night. We then returned
 towards home, we turned in to Gurdy Bach, I gave them some Tracts,
 and the good Lady said that we better eat some Bread & Chees, that we
 must be hungry, as well as tired, we accepted, and was refreshed nicely,
 and we soon arrived in Llanybyther, Bro Thos took some Tea, and came
 part of the way with me, we turned in ^{to} Bro Jones house, talked with him for
 while, he is comencing to see that we have the Truth; And therefore has not
 the confidence in his own religion, we often turned in and talk to him
 what he will do we cannot say just yet. Then I came home, Sat 17th, I
 was to home untill after noon, when I took little walk as far

 good season, talked with different ones, and proceeded to the little
 Chapel, got everything rady, and waited for the People to come, did think
 that we was not going to have anybody to come, but few came at last, we
 concluded to comence, I gave out Hymns, and also Prayed, and then spoke

 to half sole my Shoes, so while they were at them, I went over to
 where Bro Thos were stopping at, and wrote a Letter to my Wife,
 and also eat Dinner with Bro Thos, and after I got my shoes,
 (which cost me 3, 6) we started up to Lampeter, we reached there about
 6 o'clock, we were very kindly received with Bro Thos, and Sister Thos.
 We stayed all Night. Sat 24, We remained until after noon, we
 purchas'd few things, and had pleasant time, we talked to sister Thos
 concerning emigrating, and urged upon Her to be prayerful and humble
 before the Lord, when we got ready to start, we bade them farewell, Bro
 Thos gave us 3 a pease, we came down to Slanybythen, and I came home.
 Sun 25, I started over to Slanybythen, after remaining with Bro Thos
 little while, and prayed unto the Lord for His aide and assistance, we
 departed, for the purpos of going ^{to} Symonants, it being very rainy
 we did not much think to ^{go} up to the Mountain, we called by Penwern, and
 after little stop, we concluded to proceed up to the Mountain, there being
 not very good Spirit (there) we did not eat dinner, we arriv'd at the
 Spring in time, there were no one there, it being cold, and threaten to rain, after a brief
 stay we concluded to return, after we proceed'd little ways, we discover'd few
 coming, we stop, and returned, we talk'd with the few that came, for a while and
 we all thought it to cold to stay very long, we then gave them some Food, and bid
 good by, we came by Penwern, stay'd and had some Tea, after little while, we came
 down towards home, Bro Thos, came some distance with me, on my way home.

Mon¹⁴ 26, I did not leave home, done considerable writing and reading, Tues¹⁵ 27,
 Preparation was made to commence to cut some Grain, we commenced with the
 Siccle, but portion of the Grain were very short and thin, Uncle wanted I should
 get a Sether and cut it, so I went to a Farm House, and borrowed one, so we
 continued untill afternoon, when we got through, I remained home the ballance
 of the day. Wed¹⁶ 28, Nothing particular occurred, I remained home, Thurs¹⁷ 29, I
 wrote some letters in the Morning for Uncle, and in the after noon I took walk
 over to Cannarthen Shire, I expected to visit certain family, but was
 disappointed, finding the Lady not at Home, I proceeded further to see an old
 Professor, I had been with him before, He showed me through the Garden,
 which was very nice, and was invited to the House, and after some general but
 interesting conversation we had some Tea, some Tomatoes were dished up, had
 very pleasant time, the Old Pro would not hear of Unionism, He came down
 to the Village 'Lunenburg' with me, I came on home, Frid¹⁸ 30, I received
 letter from my Bro Henry, in the After noon we went into the field and
 bound the Grain, and stayed in the House the ballance. Sat¹⁹ 31, I wrote a
 letter to Henry my Bro, and helped the Falks to get a Tree cross the River
 after Tea, I went up to Park & Bedw, helped the falks to bind some
 Grain, came and shaved. Sun²⁰ 1. I went up to Clifton to a meeting
 that was to be there, Bro Evans, and Sister Evans came, and we had good
 time together, the Sacrament was administered, and we felt that we were
 blessed, Sister Evans gave me one shilling, she being very good woman. I
 remained to home the ballance of the day, reading & writing. Mon²¹ 2, I helped
 Hettie the hired Girl, to cut some grain, (the men falks been away) and
 about Noon, I met with bad accident, by cutting my finger, with a Siccle.
 through it hapend to strike a Rock and glance, but I continued untill untill
 we got through that day. Tues²² 3, I made myself useful by helping to cut some
 more Grain, I was at it all day, and by night I was very tired, could hardly
 move by night. I received letter from Bro Mover, and one from Bro Thomas.

Bro Morse stating when Conference was to be, and Bro Thos gave little of
 his trip, and of the Aestadford at Bracon. Wenth. I could not work at the grain
 I thought it to much for me, I went over to Lanybyther in the morning, sent
 Bro Thos Star; to Sister Thomas adress to Ogden, and then I came home, in
 the after noon I helped the folks to bind the grain that was cut Monday.
 Thurth 5th. I did not do much of anything, and remained about home all day,
 My finger being pretty sore, I went into the field and gathered Black Baris
 and stued them and had nice dish of them with Tea. Fridth 6th. I received Letter
 from Home, stating that they were well, and doing well. I went
 out into the field and helped the folks to turn the grain that it may dry.
 I also wrote letter to my Wife. Satth 7th. I spent the day in helping the folks
 all day, and bound the grain and gathered it. we worked hard, I was
 pretty tired. Sunth 8th. I did not leave the house untill evening, rested,
 went up to Brefach in the evening, My finger is still very troublesome.
 Month 9th. I went over to Lanybyther, and also down to towards
 Llanllenni to see a Pearson that was investigating the principles of
 the Gospel. I spent most of the after noon with him; talking and
 instructing him concerning the Gospel, was invited to Tea with a Pearson
 that lived closed by, and after considerable talking I returned home,
 very satisfied with my labors. Tuesth 10th. I went up to Llanwreny, gave out
 an appointment for Sunday 22. And after while left for Rallt Fawr to see
 the weaver, made arangement with him to make the Gland for my Wife dress,
 from there I went up to Llanpeter to see Bro & Sister Thomas, they were well.
 I stayed all Night. Wenth 11th. I remained untill after dinner, in the mean time
 I went to see surtain parties, had very interesting time. I bear my testimony
 to them, and they were very pleased with all of the conversation. I left Llanpeter
 and came home. Thurth 13th. I was round Brefach untill after dinner, had
 my Hair cut. Then I went over to see a Lady that lived about one mile beyond
 Rhyd y Pont. She being a Lady that is very favorable to us and the Gospel. I remained

with her until 5 o'clock, she being very interesting, and was very well treated, was invited to come again, I then returned home, very satisfied.

Frid 13th, I made ready to start-off for Merthyr, which I did about 9 o'clock, I took the Train at Llanbyther 10 o'clock, and proceeded on my journey through Carmarthen and Llanelli to Neath, there I had to wait two hours, and then went on, I arrived in Merthyr all right about 5 o'clock, at Neath I met Bro Abel Evans, I were very glad of having the pleasure of meeting with the Brethren once more. Sat 14th, I was round with the Brethren and had very pleasant time together, Bro Teasdale arrived about 7 o'clock, then we had Presbhood Meeting, during the same I had to go to the Station, according to agreement, to meet Sister Phos from Lampeter, but she did not arrive until next day, we gave in our reports of the last 3 months, and after the meeting, we had little instructions by Bro Teasdale, and after Prayer we retired for the night. I slept in the Star Inn. Sun 15th, we all met together in the morning, and at 10 o'clock meeting commenced, (in the Star Inn, Long Room) Bro Gurse was the first speaker, and Bro Teasdale called upon me to talk to them while I did so for few minutes, quite a number of the other Brethren was called, and we had very good time, every body was joyful. at 2 o'clock the Afternoon meeting commenced, Sacrament was administered, and many of the Brethren spoke and also Bro Teasdale, there were few came in that wanted to disturb the meeting, one of them introduced a Letter from Jarman which Bro Teasdale toned up, we had good meeting every body very satisfied. at 6 o'clock meeting commenced, the room was crowded many strangers were in, and good many wanted to keep noise but failed in their intantion of braking up of the meeting. Every body felt well and good, that came in to listen; in all we had very good Conference. Bro Teasdale gave us lots of good council in private, and he felt splendid, said that he liked to come to Wales. we agreed to have bisdriet Meeting, in 3 months. Mon 16th we had meeting together all morning! (Presbhood Meeting) and very good time

we had to gether not soon to be forgotten, Bro Seardale left us about 1:30 o'clock
 in the afternoon we held little meeting, and all settle his account, we were busy
 all day, and in the evening we had some singing, and lots of fun, and after
 prayers we retired for the night. Tues 17th, I went up to Bowls, visited
 some of the old friends, had dinner in one place, and tea at another, sold
 one Book of Mormon, talk about our folks in Utah and every thing in general.
 came back late, Wed 18th, I started off at 7:30 in the morning, met Bro Thomas at
 Kirweim, we traveled to Veth, from Veth we traveled on foot to Lansanlet,
 then we took the street-car down to Glandore station, after little rest I
 took the Train to Maescrygier, I had to stop in Carmarthen two hours, I
 stoped all Night with Thos & Margaret Davis, Llwyrn Bar, Thurs 19th, I remained
 in Llwyrn Bar during the day it being very stormy, Frid 20th, I came up to
 Maesfelin in the afternoon, walked, and gave some Tracts to Persons on the Road
 I crossed the River Dive up ^{on} castles, I received Letter from Home, all well,
 Bro Thos came over, I went over to Llanybyther, we wrote Postal cards and
 sent them to different places when we should hold meetings, I came home
 Sat 21st, I remained home all day, wrote a Letter to my Wife, and a card to
 Capt Lewis, My droilin spent the remainder in reading and resting, Sunday
 22nd, I wrote considerable in the journal in the morning, and remained
 home untill evening, when I made rudy to up to Llanybyther, to
 hold our meeting according to appointment, I reached there on time,
 pretty soon Bro Thos arrived, repaired to the School House, and after
 I procured candles, we commenced our meeting, 6:20, I gave out the
 Hymns, Bro Thos Prayed, I spoke first, occupying about 30 minutes, when
 Bro Thos spoke, we had pretty fair audience, and good order, I walked
 down with Bro Thos good ways, when I cut cross the country towards
 home. Mon 23rd, I was home in the morning, paid visit to bro fact, gave
 out an appointment to hold meeting out of doors, next Sun 29th, I went over
 to Llanybyther in the afternoon, Bro Thos and myself visited several Persons

Talking, and giving away Tracts, I also sold one voice of warning
 Bro Thos came part of the way home with me, ^{1^h} Tus 24^h This being very
 wet day, I concluded that I could not go very far, stayed to home in
 morning, wrote letter to my Bro Jenkin, and prepared dinner, (the Girl
 being away) I visited few friends, and in the evening I went up to Park
 Bede; Ewenie Jones and myself went to the Old Church together, it
 being a thank's Giving day, in this part of the country, came home alone.
^{1^h} Wed 25^h, I was home in the morning, in the afternoon I went over to see
 Bro Thos, I met him coming to over to see me; then we went down to little
 Place called Rhyddland, we spent little time in conversing with few of the
 men, stayed a while at the Saw Mill, and also in the Blacksmith Shop, I
 asked the Proprietor if he should allow us to hold Meeting in the shop some
 evening, said he did not like to do it; said that People would talk about it;
 but as far as he was concerned, it would be all right; but thought others would
 be throwing it up to him, if he should allow us, and therefore he preferred not; then
 we returned, I came home, picking Blackberries on Road side, After little while,
 I went up to the Wreack Chappel, there being sort of a concert Meeting then,
 was very interesting, but was too long a Program, I came home 10 o'clock.
^{1^h} Thur 26^h, Bro Thos called by, then we proceeded on our journey to Llanarth,
 to fill an appointment; we called in few houses on the way, when we arrived at
 Rhyddland, we were received very kindly with Mrs Lewis, invited us up to the
 House to have some Tea, had very pleasant time with her, we talked considerable
 about her duty to investigate and obey the Gospel, we then continued our
 journey, arrived in due time, but soon found out that it was very poor night
 for us to have Meeting; two others held in the Place; so we concluded to postpone it;
 we stayed all night at the Llan Renna House, ^{1^h} Frid 27^h, we went from House to
 House with the Tracts, and told the People that we would be there holding Meeting
^{1^h} Tus, Oct 8. We then continued our journey towards Cilien Park, calling in
 many houses, we tried to have the privilege to hold Meeting in a Place called Oxford

but did not have the promise, we arrived at Cilicu, in due time, was invited
 into the House by Mr Jones, and was very kind to us, Bro Thomas had Tea, I would
 not eat any, we then went down to see Mr Griffiths at Neuadd Odu, was very kindly
 received, we soon gathered to the School House, and commenced the Meeting, good
 many came though it being very Rainey and dark, and we had we had very good
 Meeting, we were blest with the Spirit of the Lord, to have much freedom of speech,
 we sold one Book of Mission, and voice of warning, we then were invited to supper
 by Mr Griffiths, we could not have a head, there through the Bed clothes being damp,
 but I preferred stopping up by the fire all Night, and so I did, but Bro Thos went on
 to Lestrath, 3 Miles away, Sat 28, I commenced my journey towards home, after
 having good time with Mr Griffiths in the Morning, I called at Mr Jones's Latin
 Fach, School, and came on to cribin, I called to see Mr Hugh, but was not at home
 I spent few Minutes in a social conversation with the Lady of the House, I
 then continued my way home, were very fortunate, to have a chance to ride home, were
 home 3 o'clock, I spent the remainder of the day in reading the Papers from Etata, Sun 29,
 Bro Thos called, and we went up to Clotforn, and concluded that we better hold
 Meeting, though we being only three, it being very wet day, the rest of the Brethren
 and sister did not come, but we had good time together, Bro Thos took to preside,
 I administered the Sacrament, and was called to speak I occupied some of the
 time, and Bro Thos spoke little while, we had very good time together; in the
 afternoon we were to hold Meeting out; the Time arrived and we were on
 hand, but the weather were un favorable, but we found little shelter, and
 good many People came together, we concluded to have short Meeting, we were
 Blessed of the Lord, and what was said, was directed by the Spirit; and we felt
 thankful, we then proceeded over to Slanybhythin, to fill in a pointment there,
 we arrived in due time, we lighted the Room and soon the People commenced to come
 together, we commenced our Meeting through giving out some of their Hymns ~~and~~
 and we got them to sing, Bro Thos Prayed, and I spoke first; 45 Minutes, and Bro
 Thos 20 minutes, after singing I closed by Prayer. had very good Meeting, lots of people,

and very good order, I commenced my way home, it being very dark, I came across a Lady that had some distance to go home alone, (to High Mead) I told her that I would go with her if she was affraid, she was very glad, I escorted her home, and she thanked me very much, then I came home, Mon 30, I was home all the morning, after dinner Bro Thos came over, then we went up to a place called, Dyck Bant; to inquire in regard to place to hold meeting next Sun 7 o'clock, we were directed to see the folks at Pantmeddig, that they owned the house where the Sun school was kept, we went in down, saw one of the Boys in the Barn, asked him of the privilege, he said, yes, it would be all right, but soon his sister called him, and here she came, to us and said that her Brother had told us that we could have the house, but she wanted us to understand that we could not come, on any consideration, that she had told her Father while he was in his beastly Bed that we should not come there any more, that she believed that that was the cause of Her Father's death, I told her that was alright, that it was nothing to us, we then came home.

Oct 1st, I wrote my Journal in the morning, and also wrote letters to Morse at Mustang. After dinner I went over to Lanybythun, Bro Thos, and myself had conversation with the young preachers, sold one voice of warning, then I returned home. Oct 2nd, After dinner, I started up to Bihewid, at the Crilind called in to one Jones, Shoe Maker, He was kind enough to ask me to have cup of Tea, and I avail myself of the opportunity. I then called at the Board School, to see Mr. Hugh, after effecting arrangement for a meeting I proceeded on my journey I reached Bihewid by Sun down, went down to Pantrehw, to see the folks, they were preparing for an action, which was to take place, the second day, after. I then went up to the School House, after which Bro Thos came, Meeting commenced 7.45. Bro Thos spoke first and occupied 50 minutes, and I only spoke for 26 minutes, we had pretty fair time, but not the form that we would like to have, very good order, and good singing. After meeting we walked down to Lestrada, 2 Miles and a half, and stopt in a Public House, Thur 3,

It being very Rainey day, we failed to leave the House, was made very comfortable in a Room by ourselves, and when the time arrived for us to go up to the Pelin Fach, we went, and purches candles, and lit up the School House, few came together shortly, and as soon as we found enough ~~we~~ commenced the Meeting, I spoke first, occupied 45 Minutes Bro Thos occupied 15 Minutes had pretty good Meeting, the People listen attentively, but we had to do the singing, we gave away few ^{Tracts}, and returned to our Logging House, ^{Friday} ^{the} we came up to Dehewid, went down to Pantrew, had something to eat, and the People commenced to come together to the Auction, at 2 o'clock the sale commenced, we stayed until 5 o'clock, and after we had Tea, we started down to Crilin, but before we reached Crilin, it commenced to Rain, and continued all Night - it was detrimental to us, for it caput many away, but we had few and held the Meeting, Bro Thos spoke first, 46 Minutes, and I spoke 20 Minutes, we had good time, we were assisted of the Lord considerable, I spoke of the BK of Amr, and sold one, we felt good, and went to our Logging, Paid one Shilling. ^{the} Sat 5, still Raining, we started ⁺ wards Home, Bro Thos going one way, and one another, arrived by 4 o'clock, I went up to Drefach in the Evening, and cleaned out the Black Smith Shop, and prepared it for us to hold Meeting in Sunday Evening, ^{the} Sun 6, I remained home all day, until Evening, when Bro Thos came over, then we went on up to Drefach, and prepared for the Meeting; Meeting commenced 5 o'clock, after the usual exercises, it became my duty to occupy the time first, I spoke for about 30 minutes, when Bro Thos spoke for 15 Minutes, the People joined in the singing, we had very good time together, the shop was crowded, and good Spirit prevailed. Then we came home, I took little walk with Bro Thos, ^{the} Mon 7, very windy day, I went up to the Drefach, carried the Benches back, and had my shoes fixed, came back home and done some writing, and prepared for a start for Talgarreg, we started 11 o'clock, faced the wind and storm stoped at Penbont Shum, 5 miles off, we gave out an appointment there to hold Meeting Sun Evening 5.30, out done. we proceeded on our jarny, called in to Sister Evans, had

something to eat. We then went on our way, called into a house on the way
 and settled the storm, gave the Wife some Tracts, she was highly interested
 in us and our doctrine. We again went on, reached Talgarry 5 o'clock, stopped
 with Mr Thos, here I caught bad cold. Our meeting commenced 7, 45. Bro Thos
 spoke for some length, will I only spoke 15 minutes. had very good meeting,
 we stiped all night at Mr Thos, Tues 8th, after nice time in the morning,
 we bid them a due, and commenced our journey towards Llanarth, we called at Farm
 House, and gave them Tracts, and the kind Lady gaved us some milk to drink,
 after traveling some distance, we came to a Place called Esgeronw, Farm,
 we were highly welcomed, were made comfortable, and was favored with some Tea,
 and had very pleasant time with them. we left our blessing with them, and
 proceeded on, we reached Llanarth only in the evening, meeting commenced 7, 35.
 Bro Thos spoke for some length, I only bear my testimony to what had been
 said, and also spoke little concerning the B. K. of Mormon, I being very hoarse
 could hardly speak, we had large audience, and good order. the School Master
 was very kind to us, he gave us the use of the Lamps, &c. we stiped all night in
 the Llanina Arms, (Public House) I took some hot Beer and bread for supper
 it warmed me up nicely, and slept very good. Wed 9th I felt little better,
 I started to write a letter to my Wife, but could not finish it, so we started off
 (paid the Lady 1, 6^{3d} a piece,) we called in few places and chatted about the
 Gospel and the People in bitah. we proceeded on our way towards Mydroglin
 we stiped on the Road, went into the field and prayed, I was inspired to go
 to a House, toald Bro Thos, so we went there, was offered something to eat, and
 sold the Voice of Warning, we were kindly treated, reached Mydroglin early,
 was respectfully received with Capt Lewis and Wife, had something to eat, before
 meeting commenced. We had very good meeting, the Lord blessed us with much
 favor, I spoke for 45 minutes, Bro Thos the reminder, every body felt well,
 especially Mr and Mrs Lewis, they bore their testimony, that liked us very much,
 they entertained us all night. and toald us to call again, that they would treat

us the best they could. Thur 10th. After we gave The Lewis family Farewell, we
 towards home, we called in at Farm House, by the name of Penlan Noeth, we
 gave them Tracts, and the old Lady invited us to stop to dinner, we thanked
 her, and stopt, she was full of fault-finding, with the Saints, said many
 foolish stories, and many proffesses that had been predicted, that never came to
 pass, but we talked and had good influence upon them, after thanking them
 for their kindness, we started off, made our minds up to call at Farmhouse, by
 the Name of Bleimen Gweinog, had very good social chat with them, and
 introduced the BK of Women, and urged it sale, we were successful, they
 bought one, and we left, and came home by 5 o'clock. Frid 11th. I am still
 suffering with cold, I wrote my letter, send it to my wife, went over to
 Langbyttan in the after noon, loved a Book Key of Philology to Bro Davis, and
 returned home, Sat 12th. I remained to home pretty much all day, it being
 stormy, wrote a Letter to Bro Pusee, and send off some News Papers,
 Sun 13th. Bro Thos came over, and we went up to Clutfurn, Bro Evans
 were there, we concluded to hold Meeting, only 4 of us present, we admi-
 nistered the Sacrament and gave some good instructions, had nine times
 about 3 o'clock we started down to pentant Sham, to fill our appointment
 we arrived 5 o'clock, was invited to the House with Bro Evans, and had to
 take something to eat. the time soon arrived for the Meeting to commence
 people commence to collect. and we went out in the open air and gave
 out some Hymn, and I prayed, Bro Thos spoke first, and I spoke little
 while, it being getting late, and cold for the People to stand, but they
 endured it patiently, and we spoke very freely, we felt well, and that
 we through the help of the Lord, had done some good as well as to do
 our duty, after little rest, and warmed up we started on our return
 trip, I reached Maesyfelin 8, 45. Mon 14th. It being very cold day, and
 I had removed cold, I did not felt half well, I wrote a letter to Bro
 Edwards, Willard Utah. I did not leave home. Tues 15th. I wrote encardade

in the morning, and in the afternoon I took over to
 Lanybyther, called in few houses, and talked to the People, and got
 acquainted, Bro Tho came to meet me as I was about to return home
 then we concluded to go and see a Family, this is favorable to us, and their
 daughter had returned home sick. We were kindly received, and spoke to
 young Lady her duty, for her health sake, she talked off very favorable
 and that she would speak to her Father & Mother, in regard to join the
 church. Then I returned towards home, Wed 16th I was home in the
 morning, it being very Rainey, after dinner I took over to Lanybyther,
 Bro Tho and myself went up to Pencareg, we called and seen Mr Davis
 the School Teacher, and arranged with him to have meeting Tuesday
 the 22, we also soald Mr Davis the voice of warning. We were
 advised to go and see one Mr Davis (massenol) He being one of the Board
 but he was not at home, but we were met by Mr Davis's Father, and was
 highly respected, he insisted that we should take something to eat.
 We had very pleasant time with him; he also bought the BK of Mormon,
 walked with us a ways, and we bid him good by, and blessed him. I
 came straight towards home. Thurs 17th Another Rainey morning, did
 not go away untill afternoon; when I went over to Lanybyther, we
 went and see if we could get the Rhydyborat School House, found the
 chairman of the Board, he gave us his consent, we then went and spoke
 to the School Master, got him to promise to give out notice through the
 children, meeting was to commence Wed 23rd 7 o'clock, then we came
 towards home, but visited some places, tried to sell some books, but
 were not successful. had to return home. Frid 18th I prepared to
 go to Lampeter, I started 10 o'clock, met Bro Tho at Llanwonno, we
 went round and saw few people, and gave out notice that we should
 have meeting there Sun Evening 6 o'clock, then proceeded on our way,
 reached Lampeter about noon, after dinner we went to ^{the} Art Gallery.

I had my Photo taken, cost 4 Shilling for 3, we visited few places
 tried to sell some books, we sold the Voice of Warning, had pleasant time
 with Bro and Sister Thomas, we retired 10.30. Sat-19th, This being a Fair
 day, the people soon commenced to gather, we enjoyed ourselves nicely all
 day, witnessed a Foot Ball Match between Lanelli, and Lampeter,
 the former wined the Match, we then returned home, had the privilege
 to ride a ways, Sun 20th, I remained in the House all day untill
 4 o'clock, when I started up to Lanunem, to fill the appointments,
 was there in due time, bought some candles, and light up the house,
 soon the people commenced to come, Bro Thos did not arrive untill after
 6 o'clock, but I waited, and then we commenced our Meeting, by giving
 out hymns, Bro Thos Prayed, I spoke first 40 minutes, Bro Thos
 then spoke for 30 minutes, we had very good Meeting, good order, I
 came home alone, very dark, Mon 21st, I wrote considerable in the Evening
 after dinner I went over the River, Bro Thos and myself went down to
 a Place called Llanelwri, with the view to engage the Black Smith Shop
 to hold Meeting in, after ^{some} preliminary we were successful; we called at
 Dol Gorse, to see Mr Harris, but he being away, his Wife answered the purpose,
 we were invited to have some Tea; which we enjoyed very much, we gave out an
 appointment, for Frid Night 7 o'clock. Then we came towards home, went up
 by Penumon, stayed there few minutes, and came on, I left Bro Thos at
 Llanbythor and came home. Tues 22nd, I was home in the Evening most
 part; went up to Parkybedw in the After Noon, stayed there untill 4
 o'clock, when I came home, and made ready to go over to Llanbythor.
 and at 6 o'clock we went up Pencaery, to hold our Meeting, we were high-
 ly entertained by School Master and his Servant Girl. Then we went up to
 the House, Meeting commenced 7.30. After singing I prayed, and Bro Thos
 spoke for 40 minutes, there some old Man there that was under the influence
 of Licoor, and was disturbing the Meeting, untill we could hardly speak, but

The rest of the People was very good, we had pretty good meeting after
 all, we sold one voice of Harming, and felt blessed, had glass of Milk a piece
 with Gihl, of Mr Davis, the S Master. and came home, I arrived home by 9,45.
 Wed 23^d I went up to Smith in the morning, and had a Plate under
 my shoe, and after dinner I went over to Lamybyther, visited few
 Places, and sold the voice of Harming, to Mr Davis the brugstones,
 and after little while we went on up to Landyan, to hold our meeting
 was followed with lots of Boys, some few People came by 7 o'clock, but
 we waited untill few more came, and the Boys capet up their saccats,
 and was very annoying to all present, we concluded to ammence and after the
 usual exercises, I spoke first, 45 minutes, and Bro Thos spoke for 20 min
 we troubled continually with the children, worst we ever experienced in the
 country, they pould up the Gate off the Hinges, and carryed it away, but
 we found and fastened it all right, and came home. I was home 9,40.
 Thur 24th I was home untill Bro Thos came over after dinner, I
 received letter from Jenkin, ^{he} was pretty well. We took a walk to a
 Place called Laachweth, the Falks being somewhat related to me,
 we were well treated, stayed untill dusk, and returned home. Frid 25th
 I wrote considerable in the morning, and went and met the Post.
 got letter from Lottie my wife, stating that they were well, and the
 little ones growing nicely. I set down and wrote letter to my wife,
 but did not get off untill next day. I went over to Lamybyther and
 met Bro Thos, and soon started down to Lanllunne to fill our
 appointments, we arrived in due time, we were well treated with the
 falks, we sold one voice of Harming to a young man by the name of
 Williams. We ammenced the meeting 7,30, after singing I opened by Prayer
 Bro Thos spoke for 45, I only occupide 15 minutes, we were aided of the
 Lord, and had very good meeting. I came up to Lamybyther and stayed
 with Bro Thos that Night, for it being so late to go to Mansfield.

Sat ^{14th} 26. I stayed with Bro Thos to Breakfast. I payed Mrs Evans
 for the Lodging, and then we took a walk up to see a Family that
 was favourable, we called in the Soavard of Rhydybont, I got few Names
 of a Family that was related to Father, we then went on, stayed consider-^{ble}
 time with this family, sold the Book of Mormon to them, and we then
 returned, I came to Maccyelin, arrived by 4 o'clock, and remained to home
 Sun ^{14th} 27. Bro Thos arrived from Langbythor, then we went up to
 Clwtfurn, to hold our meeting, no one came but us, only 3 of us, we
 held a meeting, had nice time, After Tea, I went over to Langbythor,
 to fill an appointment, the Night being very dark, and Rain little,
 we did not expect many to come, but was surprisid to see so many coming
 Meeting commenced 7,40, I opened by Prayer, Bro Thos spoke for 45
 minutes, I only bear my testimony for 10 minutes, we were blessed of
 the Lord, and had good time. I came home in the darkness, reached
 home 9,30. I forgot to make mention that I payed Uncle Thos one Pound
 £ 1.0.0 on Friday 25. Mon ^{20th} I spent little time in the Morning writing,
 after dinner I went over to Langbythor, called in by the way, and spent
 little time with Mr Jones Tailor. Bro Thos and myself went to see a Family
 by the name of Thos, I wanted to have the correct date of the death of certain
 Lady, they made us to stop and have cup of Tea. We then went to the
 grave yard of Landyar Chapal, there I found certain Lady's Name, we
 then returned, Bro Thos came part of the way with me towards home, we call-
 ed in few houses, and in one of these places, we met one of the disposisim
 to oppose us considerable, we had quite a time with him, he got wild, did not
 know what to do with himself. I came home, and Bro Thos returned. Tues ^{29th}
 I stayed to home and helped the Falks digging Potatos, we worked hard
 all day, I was very tired at night. Wed ^{30th} I was intending to take
 a trip out into the country, but it comenced to storm, and blowing hard,
 Bro Thos came over, but soon went back home, I remained in the house

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all the afternoon. Thur 31st I was round some in the morning, and repaired my Umbrella while in the afternoon, and proceeded over to Lanybyther, called in a house and got some information in regard to some of Father's relatives, just before I arrived at Lanybyther, little Boy was killed by falling under the wheels of one of the wagons of the Shows, that came in. Bro Thos and myself went round some, he came part of the way home with me.

Fri 1st. This being day that the great Fair, called Gaer santisy I went over in the afternoon, took some walk round through the Fair, some few heavy showers came to the annoyance of every body; it turn to be very cold, I did not stay very long, and returned home.

an Old gentleman, called Jenkins, cousin to Mother, came to Maesyfelin on a visit. Sat 2nd, I took the Old Gent round in the morning to see few of the places that he used to be acquainted and lived in. we called in several Places, and came home to dinner. I took over to Lanybyther, Bro Thos I met on the Road, we took walk down to a Place called Peruddol, there I found the Name that I wanted. (Sister to Father's Mother), we then walk to a Place called Rhingfas, we were invited to the House, and Mr Williams, ordered us some Tea. we presented him the Book of Common, he asked it's price, and payed for it; we bear our testimony to the Book and after short-conversation we left; and returned to Lanybyther and I came home. Sun 3rd, very Rainy, could not leave the House therefore I concluded to rest myself by reading and writing. Mon 4th, I took a walk round in the morning with an old Gent by the Name of Jenkins, he being my Mother's Cousin. I parted with him in Parkybedon then I started up to Lampeter, which I reached 1:30. Found the Folks all well, met Bro Thos there, we went round few of the People, but did not accomplish much. Tuesday 5th I visited Mr Davis the Tailor, got him to alter little

of my Coat-Coller, payed him & Pence, we also went to see the Vicar
 and asked him for the privilege of holding Meeting in the School
 House, He said that the Board had agreed not let any Meeting to be
 held there any more. appeared very kind and concederate, we offered him
 our Books for sale, would not buy, I left him couple of Tracts with
 him, and left, we went through the Grave yard, I showed Bro Thos the
 Grave of Sister Thos. we remained over Night. Then 6th after
 Brackfast and a chat with the Falses we prepared to leave, Bro Thos
 gave us 2 shilling a piece. we came towards home, and made a call at
 the Noyadd Fair, to see Mr Hughes, but he was not at home, we then
 returned, and I went down to Lanybythir with Bro Thos, there we
 found letter from Bro Morse, stating that he had been released to
 return home to Zion. And that Bro Matthews had been appointed to the
 Presidence, I took little light to eat with Bro Thos, and he came part
 of the way home with me, we turned into Mr Jones house, stayed there
 while, and came home. Thur 7th Bro Thos came over, and stated that he
 had received card from couple of the Brethren, by the Name of Evans,
 to the effect that they desired us to come down to Landysaul, that they were
 to hold Meeting there that night. we were going to go part of the down there
 enway, we started, and distributed few Tracts on the Road. we called at
 Whinivor, to see Mr Lloyed, in regard the St John School House, if
 could have the privilege of holding Meeting there some Evening, He
 refered us to the Clerk of the Board, that he may put the proposition
 before the Board at the next seting. Then we tried to get him to buy the
 Book of Mor, and the voice of Warning, but refused to buy either, we gave
 him some Tracts, and left. we arrived at Landysaul 3 o'clock, went into
 the Coffin House and got something to eat. we soon learnt of the Brethren
 and the Place of Meeting, but could not see them, I went up to Curdsville
 to see my Uncle David, he had been kicked by a Horse, was getting better

in the church, She did not charge the Brethren any for the Bed.
 We then came up towards our Home, nothing particular happened untill
 we came to St-John Church, then I went in into the School House to see
 the Master, I introduced the Book Mr, & Voice of Warning, He bought
 the latter, I gave him some Tracts, we then proceeded on our journey,
 I reached Maesfelin by 3, 30 a clock, the Brethren going over to Langbyther
 Sat 9th, I was home untill after noon, where I went over to see the
 Brethren. We took a walk up to Penwern to see the Falco, we found
 the Old Man very poorly, we stayed while and took some Tea, the Old
 Man (Bro Evans) came much better, we bid them good by, and came home
 Sun 10th. The Brethren came over to the Meeting, we went up to Clifton
 waited for a while but no one came, we then commenced our Meeting, I
 opened by Prayer, and also administered the Sacrament, and spoke
 for a while, concerning our duty as Saints. I called upon Bro J. T. Evans
 he spoke for a while concerning the Blessing we were having, and the
 prevalence was before us, Bro Abel Evans bear his testimony in the Welsh
 language, and Bro Thos spoke for a while, very encouraging, and we brought
 the Meeting to a close. Bro J. T. Evans perform the Benediction, we came down
 home, they going over to Langbyther, I went over in the Evening, we took
 little walk, and returned, had nice little chat. And had Prayers; then
 we went over to the Room, light it up and arranged the Benches; the
 soon commenced to come, Meeting commenced 7, 30. Bro Thos presided.
 Bro Abel Evans spoke first, with much force, in English, then Bro
 J. T. Evans spoke in Welsh, very forcibly, and had good influence upon
 the People. I was called to say little, did not occupy much time, but
 helped to confirm what had been said, and in a impressive manner. Bro
 Thos also spoke, and bear his testimony to what had be said, and after
 singing closed by Prayer. We had very good Meeting long to be remembered by
 every body. I bid the Brethren good by, and came over home.
