

Month 11. I remained home until after dinner, when I
 took a walk over to Larry's father, met Bro Thos on the way, we
 turned into Mr Jones, (Taylor). Mr Lewis the young man that works
 there, said that he liked the meeting, and also said that he believes
 our doctrine, we then bid them good by, and went over to Bro Thos
 home, I sent a Book of M^{or} by mail, to Thos Davis Curritowyll Near
 Landyssel. Bro Thos tremed little of my hair, then we took little
 walk to see young Girl that were sick, 'Miss Thos'. I then returned
 wards home Bro Thos came part of the way with me. Tuesth 12. I wrote
 a letter in the morning to Bro Leigh, in Penbrock Shire. (I must
 say that I wrote a letter Monday morning to Bro Morse, fare well
 Letter.) and then I went up to meet the Post man, got a R R Guide
 from America, (David Bowen) then I went on up to Llanwren, to
 meet Bro Thos. we went up to Neuadd Fawr, to see Mr Hughes,
 asked him of the priviledge to hold meeting in a School House
 in Lampeter. He was very willing, but there were three others to be
 seen, said that he would see one of the parties, and I would see another
 then we thanked him and returned, Bro Thos went up to Lampeter,
 and I returned alone, I visited good many persons, gave a
 way few Tracts, and introduced the Book of Mormon, arrived
 home at dark. Wedth 13. Bro Thos came over and we started
 out for New Inn, we visited many houses and gave away many
 Tracts. we went up to Penpont Sham, Mr Evans the Store Keeper
 bought the Walsh Book of Mormon, we also visited the School
 Master, 'Mr Thos', got him to buy the voice of warning. we then
 returned another way, Mrs Jones Gelligron, gave us some Tea,
 we talk to her concerning our doctrine, she said that it was all very
 reasonable. we called and gave away Tracts in many Houses, Sold the
 Book of M^{or} in one Farm House, and we came to Lych Bard. and

also to a Place called Penfordd, we asked the Sonith of the
 priviledg of having a meeting held in the shop, He was willing and
 we gave out an apointment for Friday Night, 7.30. o'clock. We then
 came home. Thurs 14th Rainy Morning. I spent considerable time in
 the Morning to write this journal. After dinner I went over to Lanybyther,
 I got Bro Thos to trim little of my Hair, then we went to pay Mr James
 a visit; (Baptised Preacher) we were kindly received, had to partake of
 some Tea with them, we had the priviledg of introducing the Book of Moris
 and also the principles of the Gospel, He being very reasonable man, it
 was pleasure to speak to him. We remained untill after dark, and it was
 dark to returne home, and also Rainy. Frid 15th I was home in the Morning
 received some papers from Cetah, in the afternoon, I took walk over to
 Lanybyther, I met Bro Thos at Dr Jones Taylor's Maesmillion, we stayed
 little while, and went on, Bro Thos Eat little, and I fell a sleep. We soon
 started back, to go and fill the Apointment at Penyffordd; we called
 by Maesyfelin; and arrived at the Place 7.5; there were few had come
 together, and we were toald of a Marriage that was in the neighborhood
 that many People would go there. but by 7.30, when the meeting commenced
 there were good many had come together, I gave out the Hymns, and
 Prayed. Bro Thos spoke for about 45 Minutes. I bare my testimony and
 made few remarks, for about 15 Minutes; we gave a way some tracts, and
 thanked the People for their accomodation; had good meeting, and good
 order; and we came home, very dark. Sat 16th I stayed to home all
 Morning, while in the afternoon I took walk up to the Dyobant, to see
 a Lady about having the priviledg to hold meeting in her house, some
 evening, She said that she was very willing only send her word few
 day's a head; she toald me of her Mother, that she was in the Church,
 and toald me of her parents, that they were Beared in Llancwenny, I toald
 her that I would call by, and get their Names, and would try and have

some one to work for them. She was very thankful; and told me
 to be sure and come and hold Meeting. I called by the Graveyard, and
 made a note of her Parents, and came home. Sun 17th. I spent the morn
 in the House, reading & writing; In the afternoon I thought I would
 go over to Lanybyther, and from there to Penvern to see old Bro Evans,
 Bro Thos consented, we found the Old Jent in Bead, but got up, and
 felt little better, we stayed untill nearly dark, took little to eat, and
 parted; we came to Lanybyther, and visited another sick Lady, by the
 name of Thos, while there, we concluded to go to the Abardyan Chappel,
 to hear Mr James, we enjoyed ourself pretty well; we came home, Bro
 Thos came little ways with me. Mon 18th. The Falks at Maesfelin were
 going to thrash, I helped them to carry in the Grain to the Barn, and
 also helped them little while to Thrash, and then I made ready to
 start to Mydroglin to fill an Apointment, I told the Falks, to tell Bro
 Thos that I was gon slow, I capet on going, and were gon about 6 Miles
 when Bro Thos caught up, we arrived in Mydroglin, went into the School
 to see the Master, we asked him to favor us once more, by letting the Children
 know of our intention to hold Meeting that Evening, He said that he
 would not do it: that he thought we had been there long enough, that no
 one wanted us there; and that he did not think that Trustees was willing
 for us to have the House no longer; And that our refigion, and doctrius
 was not accepted with the People, and that it was an imposition upon
 the People that ^{we} were permitted to have the House, &c &c. We spoke to him
 kindly and mildly, that if he took upon himself to put a bar in the way
 of the Gospel to reach the People, that the consequence of that would be
 upon him. we left him in disgust. we were kindly received with Mrs
 Lewis, she sent us up to the House and have something to eat, said that if
 they stop us to hold Meeting, that she would give us something to eat and a
 Night lodging, any time, Capt came Home, and were very kind, we had good time

with them, we went up to see Mr Thos the Clergy, he received us kindly,
 he bought the Book of Mor. Jus 19th, we left Mydroylin about 10 o'clock
 and went to Llanarth, we stoped and talked to people on the road, we arrived
 erey, went to Llanina House, engaged our lodgings, and then saw Mr Pies
 the School Master, said very kindly that he would publish the Meeting, and
 then we went round some, delivering Tracts, and told of the Meeting, we
 had the preveldg to use the Lampis, but I am sorry to say that none but
 children came, so we did not have any meeting. Wed 20th, we payed Mrs
 Thos 1^{sd} 6 a piece, and went up to see the Clergy, Mr Jones but thought we would
 try and sell him a Book, but lo! he was highly insulted, said that our
 doctrine was Heretic, and that he would not look at any book, nor any Tract
 and shut the door against us; he got very made. We went round to some few
 family, and gave away Tracts and introduced the Books, but no one wanted
 to buy, we then left Llanarth, and started for Talgarreg, we called at
 Esgeronw, we had some dinner, and had nice chat with Mrs Evans, we
 answered many questions, and showed her some views, she were very pleased
 with our visit, we then came on down to Talgarreg, saw the School Master
 was very kind, very willing to publish it in the School, we then went to
 Mr Thos the Taylor, were very kindly received there, they soon prepared
 us something to eat. we then took little walk, and visited many Homes
 told them of the Meeting, we returned and went over to the School House
 People commenced to come, and we opened the Meeting 7.30, Bro Thos Prayed,
 I spoke first, - and occupaid some 40, minutes and Bro Thos 30 minutes
 every body very quiet, and good singing, we bore our last testimony
 to them, and they felt it. After the Meeting we went in to a House about
 a mile of, to have little chat, according to agreement, the good Woman just
 in the Tea Kitch and made us have some Tea, we told them concerning
 the starting of Mormonism, and explained many things, and bore our
 testimony, and they confess that they were highly entertained, and received

much light, for which they were very thankful. We blessed them
 and left. After arriving to our lodging place, we gave Mr Thos the
 Book of Mor as a present, - they being so kind to us, and ^{not} charging us
 much. Thur 21st, we started towards home, on the way we called at
 a House, and entertained the man for a while, he offered us something to
 eat, and said that he never been in any of our meetings, and was very
 sorry that he did not know about the last one, told us to call again, and
 bring the Book of Mor, that he may buy one. We then came straight home.
 And to my disappointment, there was no letter for me. Frid 22. I
 done considerable writing in the morning, received Letter from Dewi
 (My Nephew) after dinner I took ^{a walk} over to Langbyther, I found Bro Thos
 writing to Sister Thos, after while, we went to Mr Evans Store, I bought
 a Tea Pot, for a present to my second Cousin, Mr Evans payed us for the
 Book of Mor which he had bought some time ago; we then went over
 to the Cabinet Shop, to about my Bot, we found it ready, I bought of
 Mr Davis, 6 Cups and Saucers, for a Present to the same. I then came home
 and after little time, I took the Presents to a Place called Pantmawr,
 I was in company of my Uncle Thos, we reached after much trouble
 in the dark. We found the House partly filled with very happy crowd,
 some laughing, but most of them talking. We delivered our gifts, and
 they were received with thanks; and highly presented, we drank
 Glass of Beer, and soon left, came home with a Lantarn. Sat 23,
 I went up to meet the Post half past 10. received Letter from home,
 were very pleased to learn that my Wife and the little Children were well
 I set down and wrote an answer by return Post, took it over to
 Langbyther Bro Thos and myself went up to see Mr Davis at Penearrag
 but he was not at home, we returned to Langbyther, and took my
 Bot over to Mrs Evans, (where Bro Thos stops,) we came over to Mr
 Jones, stayed there for a while, and I came home, and shaved.

Sun 24th. Bro Thos came over, and we went up to Cliviffurn, and held our meeting, I opened by Prayer, and Bro Thos Administered the Sacrament and spoke for a while, and I spoke for a while, we had very good meeting, we were Blessed of the Lord, Bro Thos went up to Lampeter, and I came home, I wrote considerable in the afternoon, also paid a visit to Salwen Mrs Thos being hurt; Mon 25th. I remained home all day, wrote a letter William and David Bowen's, who lives in Iowa, I also paid a visit to Pant-maror, to my Relatives, came home after dark. Tues 26th. This being very cold day, was home, and helped the folks to fix something about the factory; but in the evening I received card Bro Thos from Lampeter stating that Bro John Griffiths was there and wanted to see me, I started up directly, I reached up there 5 minutes to 8, I found Bro Griffiths there, and all the folks in pretty fair health, had good time together, Wed 27th. I slept alone last night, we met together about 9 o'clock, and had Breakfast, spent good time together in the morning, we three, Bro Thos & Griffiths & myself came down by way of Llanuwchllyn, Bro Griffiths wanted to see some Relatives, he found them all right, but did not show that they care anything about him, so we did not stay long, came down to Langbyther, we eat dinner with Bro Thos; (I should have said that there are 3 inches of Snow on the Ground) it being very disagreeable walking, we then came over to Mrs Jones, we stayed and got warmed up, I then came home, left the Brethren there, this is very cold night; Thur 28th. I was home in the morning, Bro Thos came over, we then took little walk up as far as Such Bant; we made arrangement for a meeting Sun Evening, we visited few families there, was offered something to eat but did not take any, we returned by the Grave yard, and came down towards home, I parted with Bro Thos and came home, after while I visited a family by the name of Thos and had fine chat, I sold the boxes of waring to School Teachers

I then returned Home, Frid 29th. I was home all Mor, received Letter from Home, My Family enjoying good health, And also Bro John ~~Spoke~~ Henry down Sick with the Typhoid Fever. I took over to Lamybyther after dinner Bro Thos and myself took a walk up to ~~Lamybyther~~ ^{Pencaer}, there being little money out for us for a Book, called in to see Miss Thos she being sick. I came home and wrote letter to Mr Davis, Factoryman at Pencaer, and I also wrote card to the Old Jents 'Pailors' in regard to our intention to be there shortly holding Meetings. Sat 30, I wrote a letter to John my Bro in the Morning, and in the afternoon I took the letter over to Lamybyther met Bro Thos at Mr Jones, Sailor. We soon started up to Penvern. Bro Thos had business there. We found Bro Evans much better. We started back at dusk, called on the way, to see another person that was favorable to us. we soon departed for home. We arrived at Lamybyther, Bro Thos was home, and I came over to my home. Sun Dec 1. I remained home all day, until Bro Thos came over in the evening, we then started up to Sychbant. to fulfill our appointment. we found the People assembled together and we called them to order at 7 o'clock. I gave out the Hymns and also Prayed. Bro Thos Spoke for 25 minutes. I spoke for 30 minutes. we had very good Meeting, we did not hold very long one, for the was standing up. we were kindly invited to stay and have a Cup of Tea. we did. and Blessed the Family, and returned home rejoicing. Mon 2, I took ^{and} over ^{a walk} to Lamybyther in the Morning, it being a Market Day, I was promised to have my Wifes dress goods there, the Man was to bring it to Market, I waited until I was shilled, it being very cold, at last he came, and I payed him 7 for it. and came home. I started to write a letter to my Wife. I felt the effect of the cold. Tues 3, I wrote in the Morning, I finished my Wife's Letter. and in the after noon I took it over to Lamybyther. and I was prepared for a start down to New Inn. I found that Bro Thos had gone and that the two Bros Evans had come by, and stayed with him that Night. I followed on down, reached there before dark quite a bit. we found lodging and Meeting commenced 7.30. I was supping from the cold. And it was very cold
